



Note: The last day that you can sign up for this tour is **Friday, 1 November**. We need at least 15 people signed up for this tour to go.




TOKYO BAY LUNCH CRUISE & ASAKUSA

Passport admission ranges from ¥3,000 to ¥3,900 with discount coupon. Prices are subject to change without notice.



Experience the symbol of Japan with this trip to **Mt. Fuji** and some of the mountain's related sites in this scenic and famous area. Next, walk through a forest of towering, weathered cedar trees to the famous **Sengen Shrine**. Designated as an Important Cultural Property, the shrine is one of the main attractions of the annual **Fujiyoshida Fire Festival** held every August. Afterwards, enjoy lunch and at the scenic **Lake Kawaguchi** area. Finally, take a small trek through the area of **Oshino Hakkai** (*Mt. Fuji's Eight Clear Springs*) and see all eight of the springs that have been declared some of "Japan's best waters".

MIKAN PICKING with BBQ LUNCH & ODAWARA CASTLE

The **mikan** (or tangerine as we know it) is grown in great quantities in certain regions of Japan. This tour takes you to Yugawara, a small town on the East Coast of Japan located between the towns of Atami and Ito. Noted for its hot springs and spas, it is also regionally known for its high quality harvest that includes bamboo shoots, strawberries, horseradish and tangerines. While in Yugawara, we'll visit a farm where you can pick and sample some fresh **mikans**. Next, you'll be treated to a **BBQ lunch** at the farm! On the way back to Camp Zama, we will stop at **Odawara Castle**. The Castle reconstructed in 1960 from original models and blueprints from about 800 hundred years ago. It offers a splendid representation of what the typical Japanese castle was like in the Middle Ages. The castle now serves as a museum for related artifacts of the 18th and 19th centuries where many national treasures are housed. Enjoy a 360-degree view of the city from the fourth floor of the castle.



OLD NATION'S CAPITALS in JAPAN KYOTO & NARA OVERNIGHT TRIP

KYOTO - **Kyoto** served as Japan's capital for more than 1,000 years, from 794 to the Meiji Restoration in 1868. Its first few hundred years, from about 800 to the 12th century, were perhaps its grandest, a time when culture blossomed and the court nobility led luxurious and splendid lives. It has the finest temples, palaces, villas, and gardens in Japan, as well as the most refined culture and life-style. Highlights of your visit to Kyoto include **Kinkakuji (Gold Pavilion)**, **Kiyomizu Temple**, and **Sanjusangendo Temple**.



NARA - In the beginnings of Japanese history, the nation's capital was moved to a new site each time a new emperor came to the throne. In 710, however, the first permanent Japanese capital was set up in Nara. Not that it turned out to be so permanent - after only 74 years the capital was moved first to Nagaoka and shortly thereafter to **Kyoto**, where it remained for more than 1,000 years. What's important about those

74 years is that they witnessed the birth of Japan's arts, crafts, and literature. Today **Nara** is celebrated as the cradle of Japanese culture. The Japanese flock here because **Nara** gives them the feeling that they are communing with their ancestors. Foreigners come here because **Nara** gives them a glimpse of a Japan that was. Highlights of our visit to **Nara** include the **Todaji Temple**, **Kasuga Shrine**, **Horyuji Temple** and **Kofukuji Temple**. You will have ample time to shop and browse on your own!

On the way back we will stop at **Hikone Castle**. Its donjon has three stories, rises 24-meters and has white with beautiful variegated roofs. The castle is a National Treasure, while **Tembin Yagura (turret)** and the other buildings are Important Cultural Properties.
